

## AIRCOP DISCUSSES WITH COUNTERPARTS ITS IMPLEMENTATION IN MOZAMBIQUE

Between 8 and 12 March, the AIRCOP Coordinator for Africa, the AIRCOP Coordinator for Eastern and Southern Africa and a UNODC Law Enforcement Advisor participated in an AIRCOP mission in Maputo, Mozambique. The objective was to discuss with national and international counterparts the implementation of AIRCOP in the country. The mission met with the Central Office for the Prevention and Combat of Drugs (GCPCD – AIRCOP Focal Point), the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Mozambican Revenue Authority, the judicial police, the airport authority and the EU delegation. Concrete and time-bound steps were identified for the upcoming roll-out in the country.

## NETWORK OF FALSIFIED COVID-19 TESTS UNCOVERED IN COTE D'IVOIRE

**KEY SEIZURES** 

The task force of Abidjan uncovered a network of falsified Covid-19 tests at the airport for passengers on bound to North Africa. After two weeks of observations of departing passengers' movements and verification of QR codes, task forces strongly suspected the use of fraudulent techniques from an organized illicit network. Following random checks on these flights, some passengers were found to present negative COVID tests with identical bar codes, resulting in the interception of 10 passengers. Health service agents who were supposed to scan the bar codes at Abidjan Airport were accomplices in the fraud.


