1. Any Government wishing to act as host to the Thirty-third Meeting of the Heads of National Drug Law Enforcement Agencies, Asia and the Pacific is invited to inform the Meeting. Any decision taken by the Meeting in this regard will be brought to the attention of the Commission on Narcotic Drugs at its fifty-second session.
2. The draft provisional agenda for the Thirty-third session of the HONLEA, Asia and the Pacific is annexed to the present note.
3. It would be highly desirable for the Meeting to identify the topics that would be most appropriate for consideration by working groups at the Thirty-third Meeting. In so doing, it may wish to revisit topics that have already been discussed at previous meetings, but may be further considered from some special perspective. Alternatively, the Meeting may wish to decide to request the Secretariat to informally consult Member States of the region with a view to identify topics for consideration by working groups.
4. The Meeting is reminded that the related item of the provisional agenda for the Thirty-third Meeting will be devoted to the examination of the status of implementation of the recommendations adopted at the Thirty-first Meeting of HONLEA, Asia and the Pacific. A questionnaire concerning action taken by Governments to implement those recommendations will be sent in time for completion before the Thirty-third Meeting of HONLEA, Asia and the Pacific.
