GENERAL CONCLUSIONS

- ✓ All the discussed variables are relevant but according to the sustainability and availability criteria given:
 - Current variables of the CTS (*core variables*)
 - Keep them
 - Include new disaggregation categories
 - Include new crimes in the question of cleared cases
 - New variables for the CTS (*non-core variables*)
 - Consider existing exercises (*e.g. European Commission for the Efficiency of Justice – CEPEJ*)
 - Complement the information of personnel with the private police

Police personnel

- *Databases, excel files, word files, paper, etc.*
