Objective:

The project objective is to strengthen the rule of law and enhance access to justice at the national and sub-national levels through increased capacity and integrity of the justice system particularly the judiciary. This is a follow-up to the pilot project that was successfully carried out between 2004-2006 in South Sumatra and South-East Sulawesi.

Key Outcomes

1. Justice sector stakeholders supported to develop and implement action plans to strengthen judicial integrity and capacity in 4 provinces
2. Judicial Commission capacity to monitor complaints against the judiciary improved
3. Civil society judicial-watch networks strengthened in 4 provinces
4. 120 judges and 100 prosecutors trained and certified to handle corruption cases
