The reality

At any given time, an estimated 2.4 million people are trapped in modern-day slavery — human trafficking. Women, children and men across the globe find themselves being enslaved in forced labour and domestic servitude, sexually exploited or used as child soldiers. A global enterprise worth approximately US\$ 32 billion, human trafficking affects nearly every country in the world and has become a major concern.

Sadly, indications suggest most trafficked persons are never formally identified — a cruel twist which denies them assistance when they most critically need it.
