Multi-Stakeholder Brainstorming Session: Designing Corruption Out of the System 26 November 2013, Lagunilla Room

An important challenge in combatting corruption at the global level is to understand which anti-corruption strategies are achieving impact, identify the gaps that exist, and apply this insight to achieve strategic alignment to truly design corruption out of the system.

Today, sophisticated corruption operates in a fast-moving, highly dynamic ecosystem. However, arguably, our existing anti-corruption systems, regimes and institutions lack strategic coordination. At the same time, unique opportunities to beat corruption are emerging as longstanding political, economic and social barriers are dissolving and technological breakthroughs are being achieved.

This special session hosted by the World Economic Forum's Partnering Against Corruption Initiative (PACI) in collaboration with other international organizations working in anti-corruption will be a brainstorming exercise to develop an anti-corruption transformation map – an innovative and powerful tool that would provide contextual intelligence to inform strategic alignment across anti-corruption efforts.
