IND/E40 and IND/E41: Community Wide Demand Reduction in India and Community Wide Demand Reduction in the North Eastern States of India

Duration: 1999-2003

Budget: US\$ 689,600 (E40); \$727,271 (E41)

During their lifetime, these two projects supplemented the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment's (MSJE) programme to support non-government organizations to carry out demand reduction activities throughout India. Their purpose was to strengthen the Government-based National Centre for Drug Abuse Prevention (NCDAP) and 8 NGO-based Regional Resource and Training Centres (RRTCs). Five of these RRTC's were established under project E40 and the remaining 3 were set up under E41 in northeast India. Together, the projects also built technical capacity among service providers in India who were engaged in drug prevention, treatment and rehabilitation across the country.
