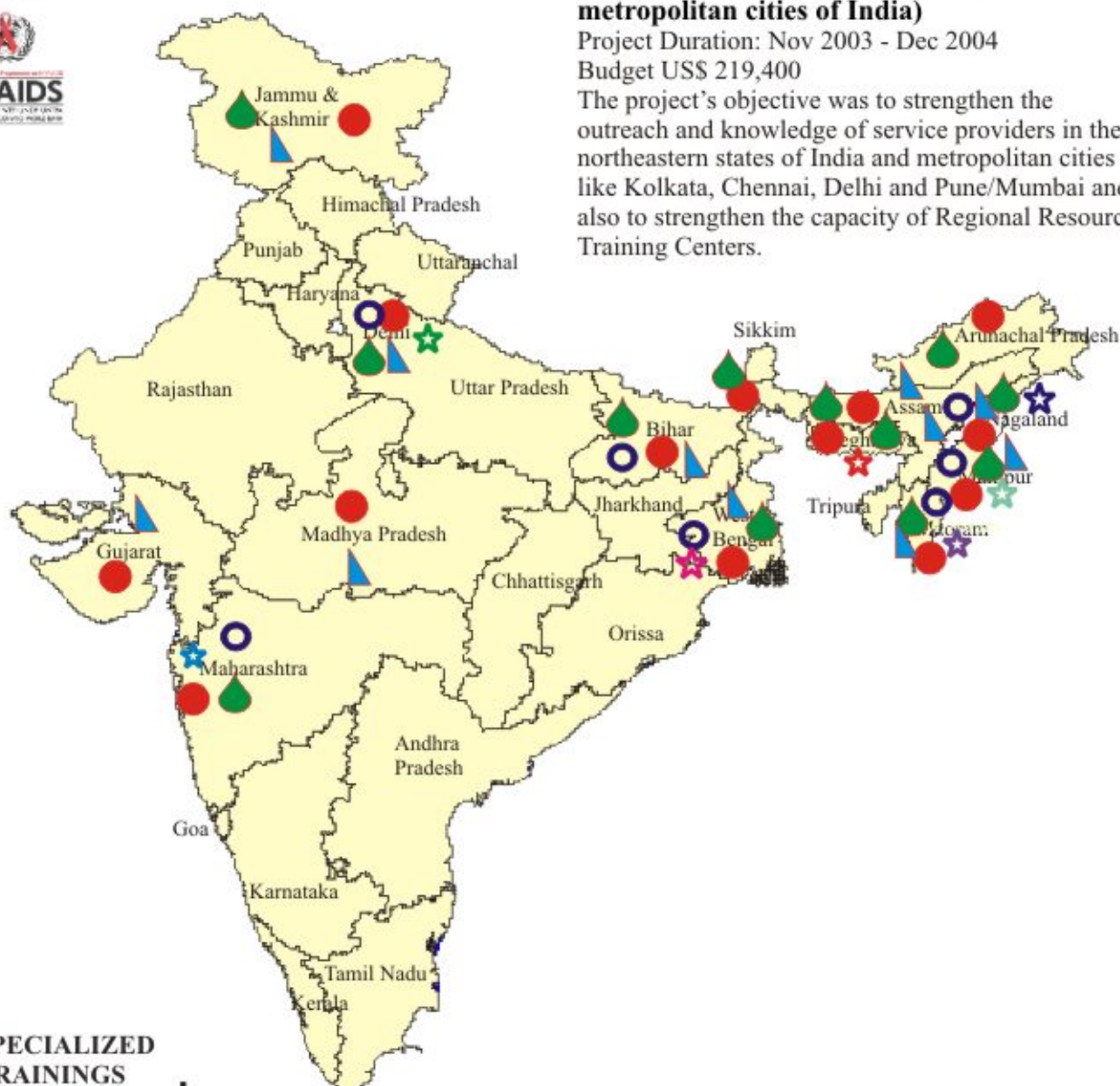


IND/G72: Formation of Peer Networks to address HIV risks in injecting drug using populations (Northeast India and metropolitan cities of India)
