

SEHAT Project launched at Amritsar Jail



India Vision Foundation has launched SEHAT (Social Education and Health Advocacy Training) project at Amritsar Prison. The project is started in collaboration with the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC).

The objective of this project is to develop health education programmes with a focus on HIV/AIDS prevention. The project focuses on rehabilitation by empowering them with life skills such

as anger management, counseling skills, decision making and negotiating skills. Amrita Bahl is the Project Director of this programme.

It was launched on April 8 at Amritsar prison in the presence of Dr. Suruchi Pant and Dr. Jayadev Sarangi from the UNODC. The prison inmates put up an impressive cultural show comprising skits and songs. Medha Agnihotri is coordinating this project in Amritsar.
