

## **Comments from Poland, covering the police section from 1995 – 2002**

### **3.2, 3.3 and 3.4 Principles of Crime registering in the Police Statistic System**

TEMIDA enable to settle whether a crime registered was stated as murder, was a carried out murder (2.2 position), attempted one (2.3 position) or with use of firearm one (2.4 position) - table 2. However there is no possibility of generating data about suspected of committing carried out murders (3.2 position), attempted ones (3.3 position) or with use of firearm (3.4 position) - table 3. In these positions there should be signed in "data is missing" in table 3.

We can only generally give numbers of suspected of all murders (table 3), That's why we added a new line titled: "Total Murders" that contains these data.

**2.10 and 3.10** Both penal code from 1969 r. and the changed penal code from 1997 (Dz.U. No. 88, poz.553), that came into force on 1 September 1998 r., do not define the category of "major thefts". In the 2.10 position (table 2) and 3.10 (table 3) there should be signed in "data is missing".

**2.15 and 3.15** Both penal code from 1969 r. and the changed penal code from 1997 r.(Dz.U. No. 88, poz.553), that came into force on 1 September 1998, do not define the category of "embezzlement ". Doubts that arose in the scope of this category, caused that in 2.15 position (table 2) and 3.15 (table 3) there were no answers provided. In these positions there should be signed in "data is missing".

**2.17 and 3.17** Increase of numbers of crimes in 2001-2002 stated as corruption and numbers of suspected of them are caused by the change of the way of calculating them. From 2001 r. as corruption crimes is also treated art. 231 § 1-3 of penal code, which means „ *abuse of rights by the public official* ”

**2.18 and 3.18** I inform You kindly that in copies of forms sent by You to fill in in the period 1995-2000, there were no 2.18 position (table 2) and 3.18 (table 3) concerning kidnappings. These positions occurred only in the forms from 2001 and 2002. I would like to explain that according to the penal code from 1969 r. as kidnappings were also treated crimes from Art. 188 „ *kidnapping from under the care and juvenile or an inept person's arresting* ” According to the penal code from 1997 as kidnappings are

treated crimes from Art.211 „*kidnapping from under the care and juvenile or an inept person's arresting*” and from Art.252 § 1 and 3 "*taking or keeping a hostage*".

**Completed data are sent enclosed in tables 2 and 3 covering the period 1995-2002, and all above explanations apply to them.**

In the form in the table 2, position 2.1 there was provided the general number of stated crimes. Beyond there are listed those crimes (according to chapters of Penal Code), which were not taken under consideration in positions 2.2-2.18 but are provided in the position 2.1.

- against the peace, mankind and war crimes,
- against the Republic of Poland,
- against public safety,
- against safety in the communication which means:  
traffic offence, that were in 2001 -10,0% and in 2002- 11.6 % of all crimes,
- against natural world,
- against freedom and freedom of consciences and faith,
- against sexual freedom and morals,
- against the family and care,
- against honour and bodily inviolability,
- against laws of working persons,
- against activity of state institutions and self-government ones,
- against criminal justice,
- against elections and referenda,
- against public order,
- against information protection,
- against credibility of documents,
- against economic turnover,
- against securities and money turnover,
- crimes from special legal acts.
