Supporting Afghan people at risk of and with drug use and drug use disorder through evidence-based, human-rights-oriented and gender-responsive drug treatment and harm reduction services to meet basic human needs in communities and challenging settings.

Description of the project

UNODC's health programme is aligned with the ABADEI strategy to improve quality of life, health and livelihoods of individuals and families at risk or affected by drug use and its negative health and social consequences.

Main interventions include:

- Prevention through parenting and psychosocial support for children, youths, and families
- Drug treatment and rehabilitation, recovery, and social reintegration of people with drug use disorders.
- Harm reduction services including Opioid Substitution Therapy (OST), reproductive health, prevention treatment and care for HIV, sexually transmitted infections (STIs) and Hepatitis, overdose management

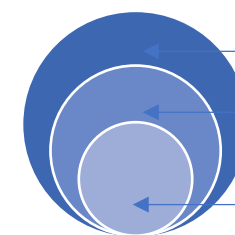
