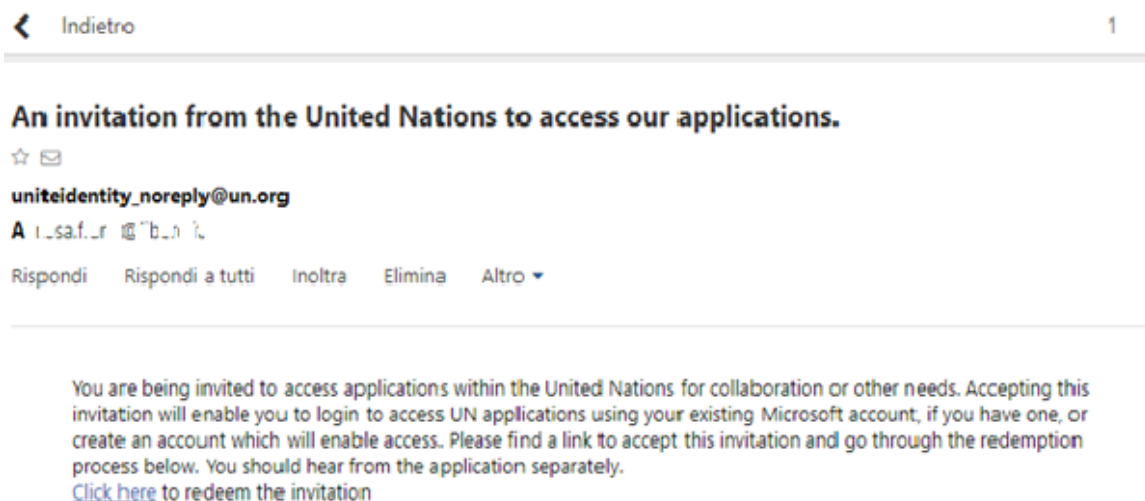

How to login in the new UNODC ARQ Data eXchange Platform?

Step 1

As newly appointed national Focal Points for the Annual Report Questionnaire (ARQ) you should have been invited to activate you United Nations guest account.

Please search in your email box for the following message coming from the following email address: uniteidentity_noreply@un.org



Step 2

If you already have a Microsoft account, please skip Step 2-5. You will be simply asked to enter your password¹ and you will be re-addressed to the unite.un.org page (Step 6).

If you do not yet have a Microsoft account, you will be asked to choose your password and to enter the name you want to display in using any of the United Nations Applications.

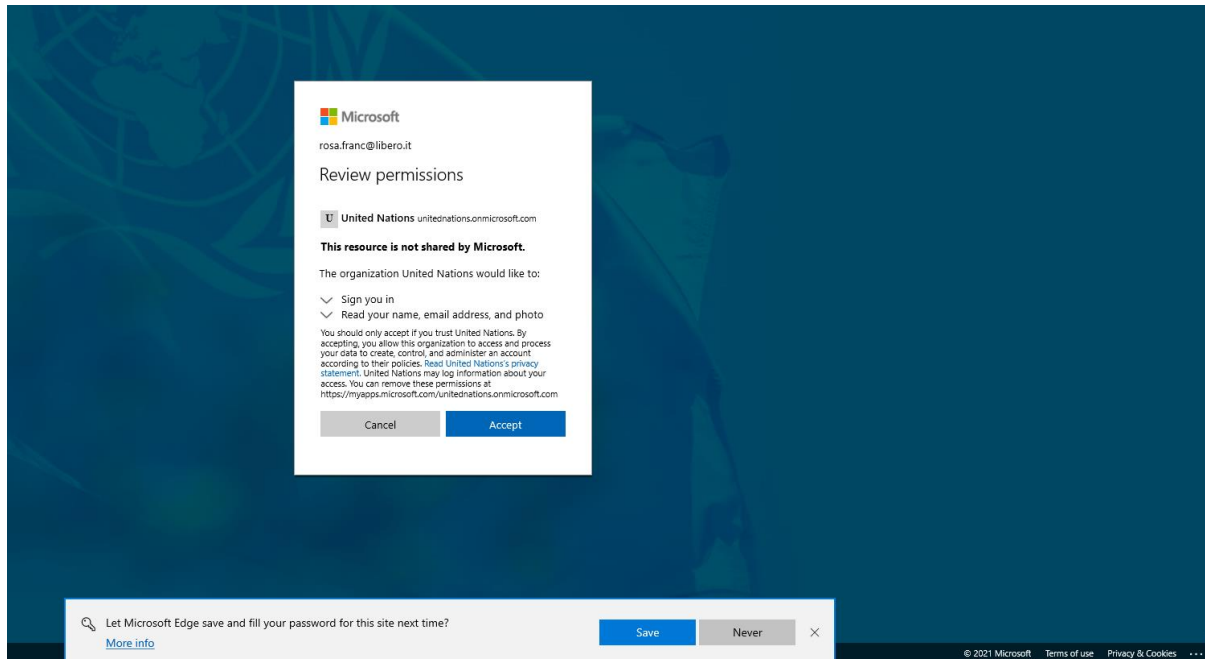
