*Article 17. Offences relating to other international treaties*

Each State Party ~~States Parties~~ shall adopt such legislative and other measures as may be necessary to ensure that [criminal] offences established in accordance with ~~applicable international~~ United Nations conventions and protocols ~~to which it is a party also apply~~ are considered [criminal] offences under its domestic law, when committed through the use of [a computer system] [an information and communications technology device].
