

General Assembly decision 78/549*

Ad Hoc Committee to Elaborate a Comprehensive International Convention on Countering the Use of Information and Communications Technologies for Criminal Purposes

At its 73rd plenary meeting, on 24 April 2024, the General Assembly, on the proposal of Mexico, recalling its resolutions [74/247](#) of 27 December 2019 and [75/282](#) of 26 May 2021, and taking note of the decision of the Ad Hoc Committee to Elaborate a Comprehensive International Convention on Countering the Use of Information and Communications Technologies for Criminal Purposes to resume its work at a later date with a view to concluding its work and providing the draft convention to the General Assembly at its seventy-eighth session, decides that the Ad Hoc Committee shall hold a reconvened concluding session of up to 10 days in New York at the soonest possible dates to allow the Committee to fulfil its mandate, and requests the Secretary-General to provide the necessary support and services for that purpose.
