Countering the use of information and communications technologies for criminal purposes

Draft decision submitted by the President of the General Assembly*

Ad Hoc Committee to Elaborate a Comprehensive International Convention on Countering the Use of Information and Communications Technologies for Criminal Purposes

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolution [74/247](#) of 27 December 2019, in which it decided that the Ad Hoc Committee to Elaborate a Comprehensive International Convention on Countering the Use of Information and Communications Technologies for Criminal Purposes should convene a three-day organizational session in August 2020, in New York, in order to agree on an outline and modalities for its further activities, to be submitted to the General Assembly at its seventy-fifth session for its consideration and approval,

Noting with concern the current situation concerning the coronavirus disease (COVID-19),

Decides to postpone the organizational session of the Ad Hoc Committee mandated by paragraph 3 of resolution [74/247](#) to a date as early as conditions permit but not later than 1 March 2021,

Confirms that the report of the organizational session of the Ad Hoc Committee, including the agreed outline and modalities for the further activities of the Committee, and any budgetary implications, shall be submitted to the General Assembly at its seventy-fifth session for its consideration and approval.

* In order for the General Assembly to take action on the present proposal, it will be necessary to reopen consideration of agenda item 107 and to consider it directly in the Assembly.
