Jeanette KROES is a Criminal Intelligence Analyst based at INTERPOL's headquarters in Lyon, France. She commenced her work with INTERPOL in 2006 at the Office of the INTERPOL Special Representative to the United Nations in New York, NY where she was largely focused on developing the cooperation between INTERPOL and UNODC to counter human trafficking, specifically combatting child-sex tourism in Southeast Asia. She began working as a Criminal Intelligence Analyst in Lyon in 2010, conducting both operational and strategic crime analysis on various crime topics. In more recent years, Jeanette's work has been dedicated to developing strategic analysis at INTERPOL, developing transnational threat assessments for specific regions and targeting designated crime areas. In 2020, INTERPOL decided to develop an INTERPOL Global Threat Assessment in partnership with the University of Birmingham's Institute for Global Innovation. Jeanette is responsible for this initiative, including the coordination between all contributors and the production of the final report.
