

## **GUIDELINES FOR THE USE OF THE VIC CATERING FACILITIES DURING THE 64th CND SESSION IN LIGHT OF THE COVID-19-RELATED MEASURES**

The present guidelines provide delegations with information on the arrangements for the cafeteria and coffee corners at the Vienna International Centre (VIC) that will be in place during the 64th Session of the Commission on Narcotic Drugs (CND), in light of the COVID-19-related measures and restrictions.

### **Main Cafeteria**

- The main cafeteria will be open from 07:30 to 15:00. Coffee, tea, pastries and sandwiches will be available throughout and up to five warm dishes from 11:30 to 14:30. The demand will be monitored closely each day and can be adjusted as required.
- EUREST Catering Service will be informed about the lunch breaks of the reconvened sessions to minimize long queues and crowding;
- When entering the cafeteria, all patrons will need to sanitize their hands and must wear face masks (FFP2) while waiting at the food serving areas in the cafeteria;
- All menus prepared in the cafeteria are also offered as 'take-away';
- Floor stickers will mark physical distances to be kept by patrons in all common areas, including catering facilities.

### **Coffee Corners**

- The coffee corner on C07 will be open from 08:30 to 16:00 for take-away. Coffee corners in the M Building will be closed. The coffee corner on C07 in the C Building is equipped with specific hygiene measures (e.g. plexiglass, no self-service and distance markings by floor stickers).

### **Restaurant & Bar**

The restaurant and bar will be closed until further notice.
