

## JUSTICE LYNNE C. LEITCH

Lynne Leitch graduated from Western Law in 1978 and practiced commercial law until her appointment to the Superior Court of Ontario in 1992. She was appointed a Regional Senior Judge by the Minister of Justice in November 2003 and served in that position until November 2009 when she was re-appointed as a judge of the Superior Court.

She is a Past President of the Canadian Superior Courts Judges' Association and former Chair of the Committee responsible for submissions on behalf of the Canadian judiciary to the quadrennial Judicial Compensation and Benefits Commission.

As the nominee of the Chief Justice of Ontario, she served two terms as Chair of the Judicial Appointments Advisory Committee for South and West Ontario.

She has participated in many international justice projects and is a member of the Judicial Advisory Committee to the Commissioner for Federal Judicial Affairs on International Engagement.

She is the President of the Commonwealth Magistrates' and Judges' Association and previously Chaired that Association's Gender Section.

She also serves on the Advisory Board for the Global Judicial Integrity Network – United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime.

She has been appointed to Chair the Ontario Electoral Boundaries Commission established to review Ontario's federal electoral districts following the 2021 decennial census.
