Edward van Asch has been working since 2012 at the Secretariat of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) to support the development and coordination of the International Consortium on Combating Wildlife Crime (ICCWC) and the implementation of the ICCWC Strategic Programme. He was previously based in Thailand where he worked for the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC), the United Nations Environment Program (UNEP) and TRAFFIC Southeast Asia, and was involved in key regional initiatives and projects to increase cooperation and strengthen the capacity of government and law enforcement to counter illegal trade in wildlife. He holds a PhD from the University of Sheffield (UK) on the effectiveness of international cooperation to combat transnational organized crime, with a focus on the illegal wildlife trade in Southeast Asia, as well as a master's degree in international criminology and a degree in International Relations with French.
