



**ANDREI FURDUI**

**BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

**Director, Department for Crime Prevention, Ministry of Justice**

Since 2016, Mr. Andrei FURDUI has been the director of the Department for Crime Prevention of the Romanian Ministry of Justice. In this capacity, he has also been heading the Secretariat of Romania's National Anticorruption Strategy (NAS). Previously he had served as deputy director and legal advisor in the same department.

As head of the Secretariat for several of Romania's anti-crime strategies, Mr. Furdui has extensive experience in the field of crime prevention. For the past years he has been involved in drafting and monitoring the implementation of Romania's crime prevention policies in the fields of anticorruption, anti-organized crime and social reintegration of offenders. As part of the role played by the NAS Secretariat, Mr. Furdui has coordinated a large number of peer-review missions in public institutions, aiming at assessing their compliance to anticorruption standards and regulations.

For the past 7 years, Mr. Furdui has also been the Chair of the National Committee for the Social Reintegration of Offenders and is currently involved in developing the national public policy on reducing re-offending.

Mr. Furdui has represented the Romanian Ministry of Justice to various regional and international organisations and cooperation formats, such as: Regional Anticorruption Initiative, Council of Europe's GRECO, OECD's Working Group on Bribery, OECD's Working Party of Senior Public Integrity Officials, the International Anticorruption Academy, the European Partners against Corruption / European contact-point network against corruption, the UNCAC and UNTOC review mechanisms, the United Nations Commission for Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice, etc.

Mr. Furdui was born on 7 May 1977, is married and has one child. He is fluent in English.
