Esther Zubiri is a Spanish State Attorney with over twenty-five years of experience in counter-terrorism and sanctions regimes. In 2021, she was appointed by the United Nations Secretary-General as a Security Council expert of ISIL(Da'esh)/Al-Qaida/Taliban Analytical Support and Sanctions Monitoring Team. Previously, she worked as a Senior Expert at the United Nations Office of Counter Terrorism and the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime. In 2013, she served as the Chief of Justice, Rule of Law, and Human Rights at the United Nations Development Program and the United Nations Assistance Mission in Afghanistan. In 2012, she was appointed as the Agent of Spain to the European Court of Human Rights and the Council of Europe, and member of the Committee of Experts on Terrorism. As a State Attorney Chief, she led the investigation and prosecution of high-profile terrorist cases. She holds a J.D. Degree in Law and a Master's Degree in Law and Economics from the Comillas Pontifical University of Madrid (ICADE). She has been awarded with the Merit Cross of the Spanish National Police and the Silver Cross of the Spanish Civil Guard.
