

Sebastian Bley is serving as Head of the Serious Fraud Team within the European Financial and Economic Crime Centre (EFECC) at Europol since February 2021. In this capacity, he oversees the Analysis Projects for serious and complex fraud, excise fraud and VAT fraud.

From 2016 to 2021, Sebastian Bley was seconded to the INTERPOL General Secretariat in Lyon by the German Federal Criminal Police Office (BKA) for five years. He served as the Head of the Anti-Corruption Unit and was responsible for the areas of corruption, sports corruption incl. doping, and asset recovery.

Sebastian Bley began his service as police officer at the German Federal Criminal Police Office (Bundeskriminalamt) in 2004. After serving in a unit for international police communication at the BKA's Serious and Organized Crime Directorate, he has specialised since 2008 in economic and financial crime: From 2008 to 2012 as an investigator, and from 2012 to 2016 as Coordinator and Assistant to the Head of the Economic and Financial Crimes Sub-Directorate in the BKA.

He holds the degree of Diplom Verwaltungswirt (FH) of the University of Applied Sciences for Public Administration of the Federal Ministry of Interior.
