

1995/242. Organization of the work of the fifth session of the Commission on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice

At its 49th plenary meeting, on 24 July 1995, the Economic and Social Council decided that the Commission on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice should at its fifth session be provided with full interpretation services for a total of fourteen meetings, in addition to plenary meetings, for informal consultations on draft proposals and for meetings of open-ended working groups, the precise allocation of time for the different meetings to be determined by the Commission at its fifth session under the item entitled "Adoption of the agenda and organization of work", on the understanding that no more than two meetings would be held concurrently, in order to ensure maximum participation of delegations.
