Heroin and Ibogaine Assisted Treatments in the Era of the Covid-19 Crisis

The COVID-19 pandemic represents an international emergency that globally threatens individual and collective health and the local economies. Currently, the most important protective measures against the COVID-19 are based on everyday preventive actions including staying home and hygienic practices. As part of the collectivity, People Who Use Drugs (PWUD) represent a key population that could have an increased risk for the COVID-19 infection because of their behaviors, vulnerabilities and the related social and environmental settings.
