

Juan Manuel Núñez López is an advisor to the Directorate of Drug Policy and Related Activities of the Ministry of Justice and Law of Colombia. He is the expert in charge of the implementation and monitoring of Pillar 3 of Ruta Futuro: the comprehensive policy to address the drug problem, which is focused on the development of a strategy to strengthen institutional capacities aimed at dismantling drug-related criminal organizations. Mr. Núñez is an Internationalist from the Universidad del Rosario, with 8 years of experience in matters related to the implementation of drug policy and citizen security. He is further a graduate of the United Nations Ceasefire Mediation and Management Course of the UN Department of Political Affairs. From 2019 to 2021, he served as an advisor to the Directorate for the Substitution of Crops for Illicit Use in the Presidential Council for Stabilization and Consolidation, and within the framework of the Territory Renewal Agency. Previously, he served as an advisor at the Ministry of Justice and Law on the development and implementation of methodological guides for a comprehensive approach to the commercialization of illicit drugs (2015-2018), and as a researcher at the Center for Study and Analysis in Coexistence and Citizen Security (CEACSC) of the Government Secretariat of the Mayor's Office of Bogotá, DC (2014-2016).
