



Adv. Priya Biseswar is currently appointed as a Special Director of Public Prosecution, stationed at the Asset Forfeiture Unit (AFU) within the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) of South Africa. After completing a BA/LLB at the University Of Kwa-Zulu Natal (Durban), she started a career within the NPA as a criminal prosecutrix in 1997. She subsequently joined the AFU in 2002 where she progressed to the position of Regional Head (Pretoria) in 2014.

In 2021, Adv. Biseswar was appointed as Special Director: Public Prosecutions, AFU. Adv. Biseswar has extensive experience not only in Asset Recovery, but also with international obligations in respect of conventions, to which South Africa is a signatory.
