

Biography of Mr. Daoming ZHANG

Currently Mr. Daoming ZHANG is Director for international cooperation at the Office of China National Narcotics Control Commission. Among 27 years of law enforcement experience, Mr. Zhang served 12 years at the General Secretariat of International Criminal Police Organization (INTERPOL) on different positions, including Chief of Drugs Branch, Assistant Director of Global Outreach and Regional Support Directorate, and Assistant Director of Organized and Emerging Crime Directorate. In addition, Mr. Zhang also worked in the areas of drug demand reduction and harm reduction, in particular on preventive education and providing treatment and support to people who use drugs that helps them reintegrate into the society. Mr. Zhang holds a master degree in law and is a visiting professor at the Chinese People's Public Security University.
