Mr. Rodley Carza joined the Philippine Department of Health (DOH) in 2012. He is currently the Chief of the Policy, Planning, Standards and Research Division of the DOH's Health Promotion Bureau, where he provides strategic sectoral and intersectoral policy and research directions towards healthy public policy.

With a decade of experience in public health and health policy, Mr. Carza has been instrumental in strengthening health promotion policies and systems in the Philippines. He led the development of the Philippine Health Promotion Framework Strategy (HPFS) 2030, which prioritizes the prevention of substance abuse including the use of dangerous drugs, to reduce or eliminate its ill effects and associated health conditions with the goal of promoting health, wellbeing and equity.

Mr. Carza holds a bachelor of science degree in nursing from the Far Eastern University and a master's degree in public health from the University of the Philippines Manila.
