Police Inspector General Agus Irianto graduated from the Police Academy in 1990, and started his police career as Head of the Narcotic and Drugs Unit, Metropolitan Resort Police of Center Jakarta. He attended several career development courses in Indonesia as well as overseas, such as the FBI.

He has a university degree in law and a master degree in police science from the University of Indonesia and Ph.D in public policy from the University of Birmingham.

He filled several important positions in the police before he was appointed as the Deputy for Legal Affairs and Cooperation of the National Narcotics Board (BNN) in 2022 until present. He has actively participated in bilateral and multilateral meetings related to narcotics. As a member of the Indonesian delegation, he strengthened cooperation with other countries in drug eradication efforts. Agus Irianto has also conducted significant research.
