

Rajesh Srivastava

Mr. Rajesh Srivastava has been working as Precursors Expert in the Precursors Control Section of the Secretariat of the International Narcotics Control Board (INCB) effective 3 August 2020.

An officer of the Indian Revenue Service (Customs & Indirect Taxes), prior to his appointment in the INCB on secondment from the Government of India, Mr. Srivastava served with the Government of India in different Narcotics and Customs formations, for 27 years. In this period he gained experience of working with all the relevant agencies related to drug supply reduction in India – as Deputy Director General in India's nodal agency for drugs, the Narcotics Control Bureau, as Director (Narcotics Control) in charge of policy making for drug matters in the Ministry of Finance and as Deputy Narcotics Commissioner under the Central Bureau of Narcotics, exercising control over licit opium poppy cultivation and international movement of narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and precursor chemicals.

Mr. Srivastava holds a master's degree in Public Policy and Management from the Indian Institute of Management, Bengaluru/ Maxwell School, Syracuse University, New York.
