1961 CONVENTION

Decisions are taken by a simple majority of the Commission members present and voting. “Members present and voting” in this context means members casting an affirmative or negative vote. Members that abstain from voting are considered as not voting.

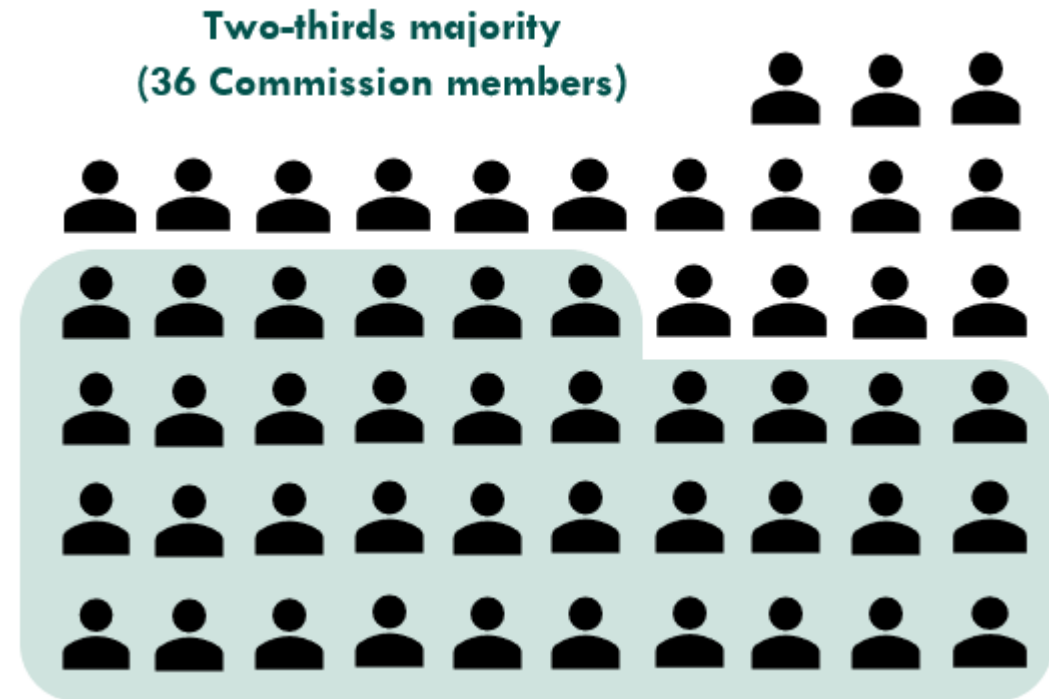

- **bromazolam** in Schedule IV of 1971 Convention.

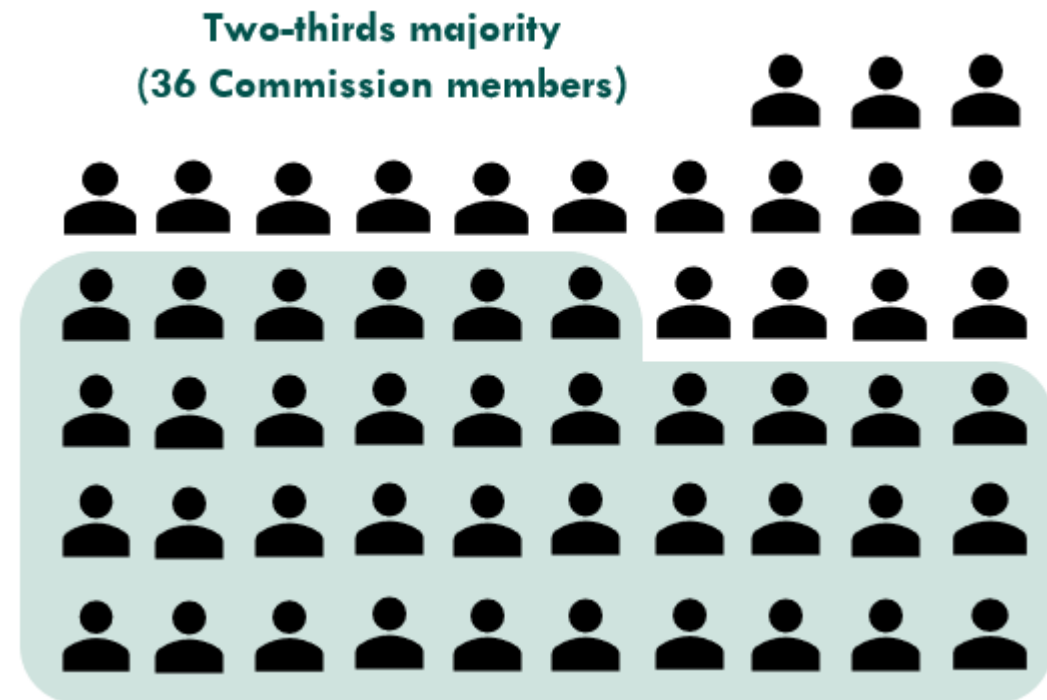

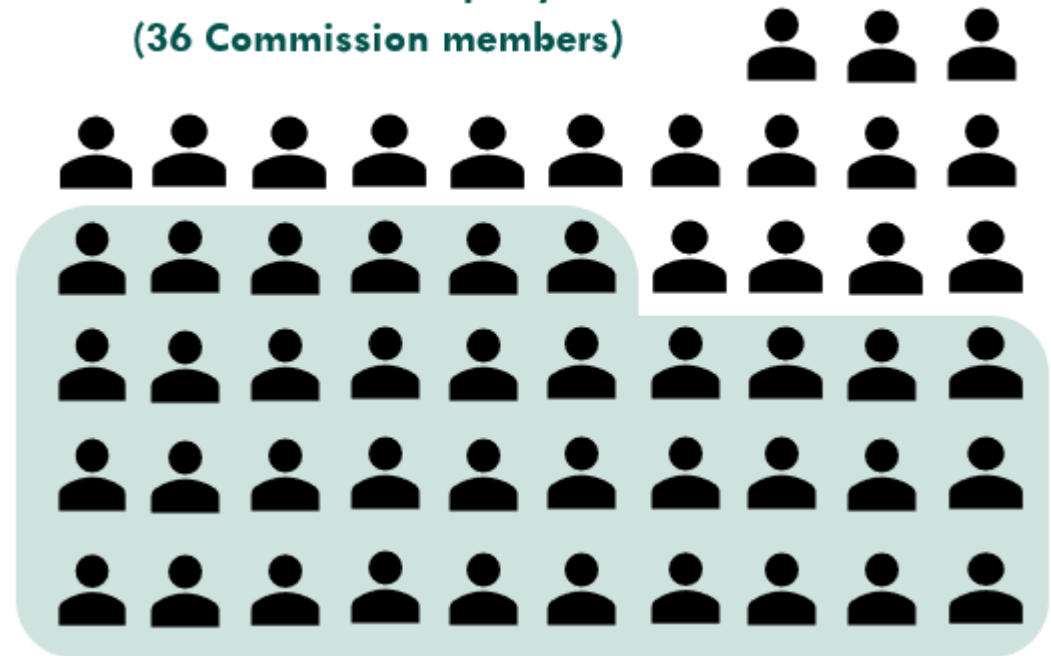

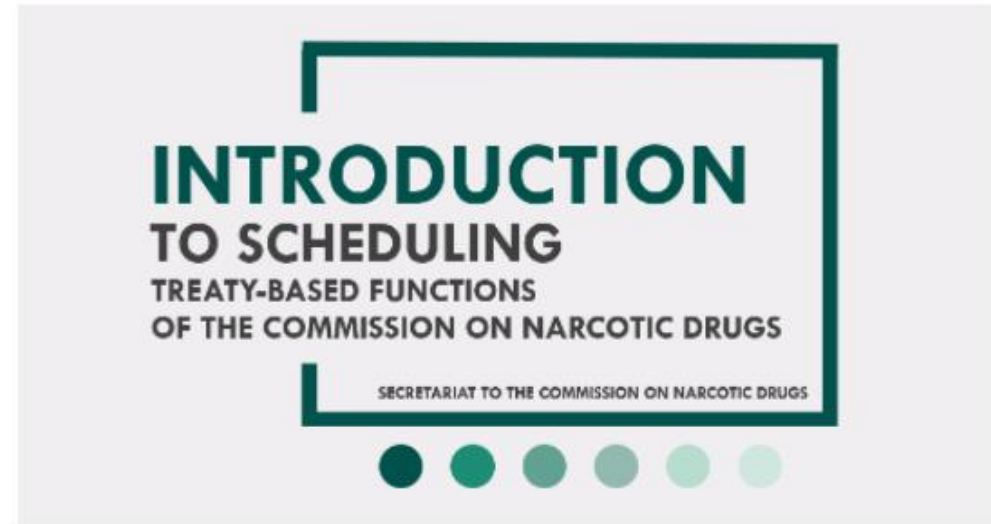
BROCHURE ON SCHEDULING PROCEDURES

This publication provides an introduction to this treaty-based function of the Commission. The second part explores the control regimes of the schedules of the 1961 and 1971 Conventions and the tables of the 1988 Convention.
