Moreover, the Commission recommended that the Economic and Social Council should remind Governments parties to the Convention of 19 February 1925 that they are under the obligation to send to the Permanent Central Opium Board statistics of drugs, whether synthetic or not, which were brought under this Convention in virtue of its article 10, and request Governments to send for the information of the Permanent Central Opium Board and the Supervisory Body estimates of requirements in these drugs together with the estimates to be furnished under articles 2 to 5 of the 1931 Convention.
