

OTHER DECISIONS TAKEN BY THE COUNCIL DURING ITS FORTY-SECOND SESSION

Election of officers of the Council for 1967

At its 1460th meeting, held on 8 May 1967, the Council elected Mr. Milan Klusák (Czechoslovakia) President of the Council for 1967. According to rule 20 of the rules of procedure, as amended by its resolution 1193 (XLI) of 20 December 1966, the Council elected three Vice-Presidents: Mr. Manuel Varela (Panama), Mr. Maxime-Léopold Zollner (Dahomey) and Mr. Majid Rahnema (Iran).

Election of members of the functional commissions of the Council

At its 1472nd meeting, held on 31 May 1967, the Council elected one third of the membership of the Statistical Commission, the Population Commission, the Commission for Social Development, the Commission on Human Rights, the Commission on the Status of Women and the Commission on Narcotic Drugs.
