CND Dec.1(XXX). Improved co-operation in drug law enforcement between States in the Near and Middle East and in Europe

At its 924th meeting, on 8 February 1983, the Commission on Narcotic Drugs decided to request the Division of Narcotic Drugs to convene a meeting between the heads of national drug law enforcement agencies from States in the Near and Middle East and Europe, and to report thereon to the Commission at its next regular session following that meeting. The Government concerned should be invited to co-operate with the Division of Narcotic Drugs in this endeavour and to allocate the necessary national financial resources to make their representatives' participation possible. The United Nations Fund for Drug Abuse Control is invited to consider providing, following appropriate consultations, and where necessary, any additional expenses that might be incurred in connection with the meeting, especially if the absence of support from that Fund meant that any State could not be represented.
