CND Dec.3(XXX). Controlled delivery in the fight against the illicit drug traffic

At its 924th meeting, on 8 February 1983, the Commission on Narcotic Drugs decided to ask the Secretary-General, in co-operation with the International Criminal Police Organization (ICPO/Interpol) and the Customs Co-operation Council, to prepare and distribute to appropriate national drug law enforcement agencies a comprehensive paper on controlled delivery and on practical ways of applying the technique. In this manner, awareness of this potential counter-measure to the illicit drug traffic would be more widely generated in those States whose constitutional, legal and administrative systems enabled it to be employed. The Division of Narcotic Drugs would be asked to report again on this subject to the Commission at its next regular session, giving information obtained from Member States of further experience gained as to the value of the technique, in order to enable the Commission to determine if it would be justified in recommending that the technique be more widely adopted.
