

At its 954th meeting, on 13 February 1985, the Commission on Narcotic Drugs noted that there was great difficulty in identifying, with precision, sources of supply of illicit narcotic raw materials, and decided to request the Secretary-General to make arrangements to assist the Governments concerned, in consultation with them, to identify with accuracy such sources of illicit supply, in order to assist the Governments concerned, with the support of the international community if necessary, to eradicate such illicit supply.
