

Inclusion of buprenorphine in Schedule III
of the Convention on Psychotropic Substances

At its 1,015th meeting, on 6 February 1989, the Commission on Narcotic Drugs, in accordance with article 2, paragraph 5, of the 1971 Convention on Psychotropic Substances, decided that 21-cyclopropyl-7-alpha-[(S)-1-hydroxy-1,2,2-trimethylpropyl]-6,14-endo-ethano-6,7,8,14-tetrahydro-orphavine (also referred to as buprenorphine) should be included in Schedule III of that Convention.
