

Decision 4 (XXXIV)

Termination of the exemption by the Government of the United States of America of 55 preparations containing butalbital from certain control measures provided in the Convention on Psychotropic Substances, 1971*

At its 1045th meeting, on 29 April 1991, the Commission on Narcotic Drugs, in accordance with article 3, paragraph 4, of the Convention on Psychotropic Substances, 1971, decided to terminate the exemption by the Government of the United States of America of the 55 preparations listed below (see the note by the Secretary-General of 8 November 1990 (NAR/CL.19/1990)), so that the requirements of article 12, paragraph 2, of that Convention should apply to those preparations.

1. Acetaminophen 325 mg, Butalbital 50 mg	(per tablet) Acetaminophen 325.0 mg Butalbital 50.0 mg
2. Acetaminophen 500 mg, Butalbital 50 mg	(per tablet) Acetaminophen 500.0 mg Butalbital 50.0 mg
3. Amaphen, reformulated	(per capsule) Acetaminophen 325.0 mg Butalbital 50.0 mg Caffeine 40.0 mg
4. Anolor 300	(per capsule) Acetaminophen 325.0 mg Butalbital 50.0 mg Caffeine 40.0 mg
5. Anoquan, modified formula	(per capsule) Acetaminophen 325.0 mg Butalbital 50.0 mg Caffeine 40.0 mg
6. Axotal	(per tablet) Acetaminophen 650.0 mg Butalbital 50.0 mg
