

Decision 5 (XXXV)

Inclusion of hydrochloric acid, excluding its salts, methyl ethyl ketone (2-Butanone: MEK), potassium permanganate, sulphuric acid, excluding its salts, and toluene in Table II of the United Nations Convention against Illicit Traffic in Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances, 1988**

At its 1068th meeting, on 9 April 1992, the Commission on Narcotic Drugs, in accordance with article 12, paragraph 5, of the United Nations Convention against Illicit Traffic in Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances of 1988, decided that hydrochloric acid, excluding its salts, methyl ethyl ketone (also referred to as 2-Butanone or MEK), potassium permanganate, sulphuric acid, excluding its salts, and toluene should be included in Table II of that Convention.
