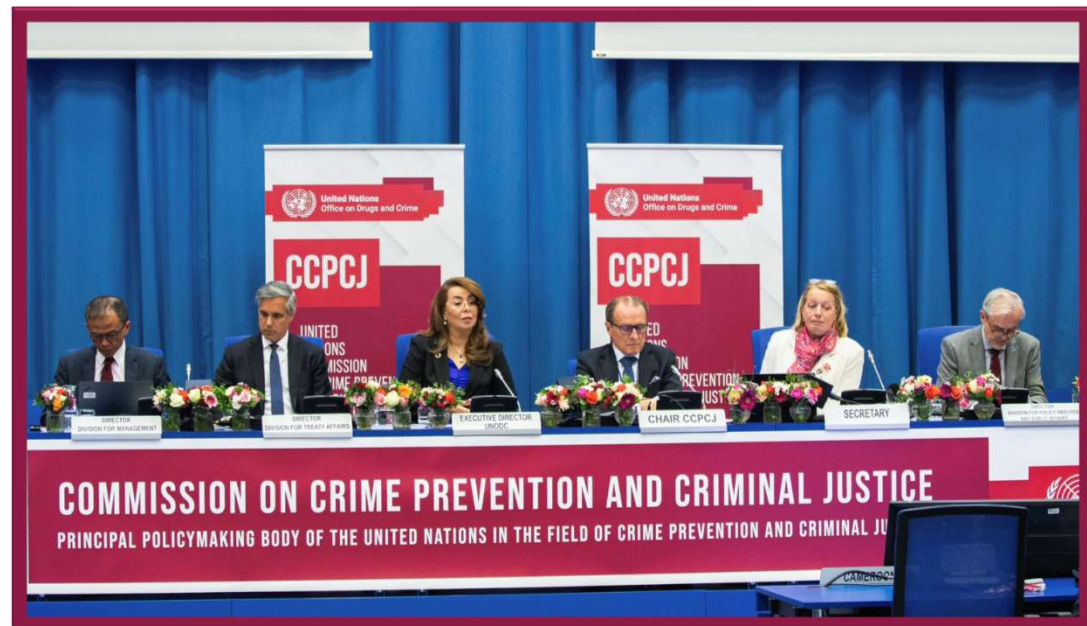

Proposals made to contribute to Agenda 2030

- Raise the profile of the **2030 Agenda during the proceedings of Commission sessions** (e.g. *thematic meetings focusing explicitly on SDG16, structuring agenda more closely according to objectives of SDG16*)
- Ensure a **broad representation of States and stakeholders** during the Commission's sessions (e.g. *developing countries, countries with high rates of violence*)
- Enhance the instrumental role of the CCPCJ in **information-sharing, the exchange of experience and good practices in specific areas** (e.g. *crime and violence prevention, prison reform, gender-based violence, and others*)
- Strengthen its role in **technical assistance** and the development of tools (e.g. *identify partners for common projects, avoid duplication and promoting international partnerships*)
- Further explore the potential of **digital technology** and technological innovation (e.g. *develop model strategies and practical measures on the equitable and inclusive use of digital innovation*)
- Further advance the CCPCJ's role in promoting **data collection and evidence-based approaches** (e.g. *research initiatives, innovative projects, collection of gender-and age- disaggregated data*)
