

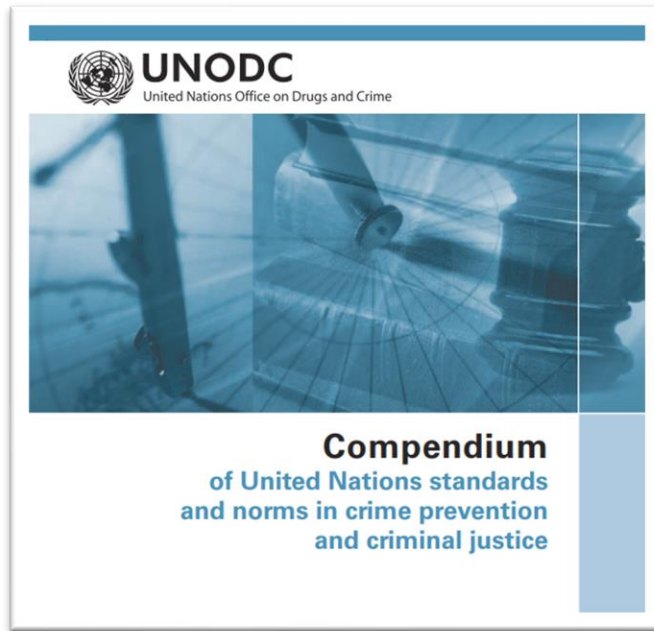

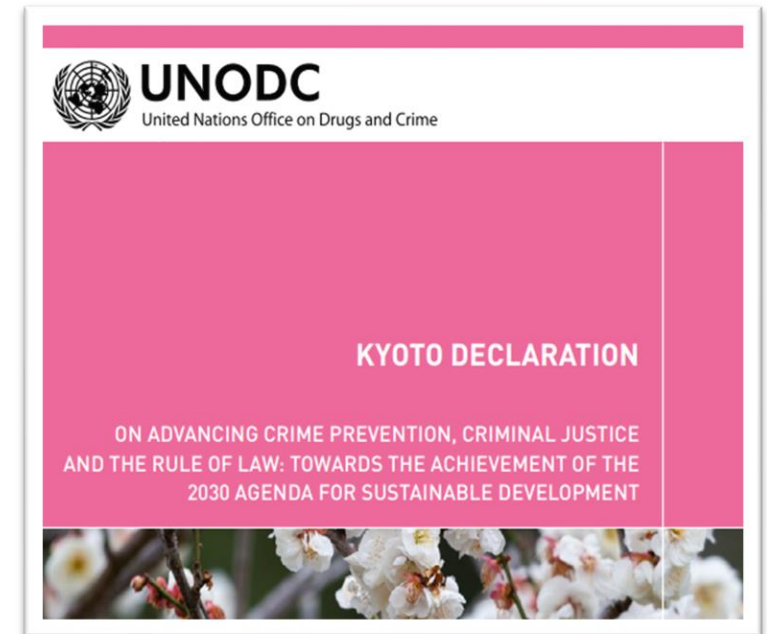

A comprehensive set of standards and norms relating to *inter alia*:

- Treatment of prisoners, including women prisoners, non-custodial sanctions, and restorative justice
- Justice for children
- Crime prevention, violence against women and victim issues
- Fair, humane and effective criminal justice systems, access to legal aid



- Latest framework for action outlining commitments of Member States in the field of crime prevention and criminal justice
- UNODC supports translating these commitments to operational initiatives
- Drafting of Model Strategies on Reducing Reoffending

# Preventing and responding to violence against women and children

- Deliver advisory service to align national legislation and policy frameworks with international standards
