Joint draft resolution submitted by the delegations of
Egypt, Indonesia, Iraq, Pakistan and Syria

The First United Nations Congress on the Prevention of Crime and the Treatment
of Offenders

Having adopted the Standard Minimum Rules for the Treatment of Offenders, and
the Recommendations concerning Open Institutions and the Selection and Training of
Personnel,

Expresses the hope that in order to facilitate the implementation of the
above-mentioned Rules and Recommendations, the United Nations will provide technical
assistance to those governments requesting it, either in the form of sending
experts needed or by helping in the establishment of institutions for the training
of personnel or by the organisation of Seminars or by the publication of guides
or handbooks to facilitate the application of the Standard Minimum Rules and the
Training of Personnel.
