ARMENIA (EIGHTH MEETING)

Field of General Education

The following topics on the fundamental values of human being are included in the “Social Science” textbooks of 8-12th grades at all schools of general education in Armenia:

- ✓ concept of freedom
- ✓ moral sides of justice
- ✓ social equality
- ✓ responsibility and tolerance

In the “World History” textbooks of 12th grade of high schools of Armenia the topic on “Fighting against international terrorism, trafficking and drug addiction” is involved.

In the general education schools of Armenia “Healthy way of living” subject is taught in 8-11th grades.

In 2015 “How to prevent violence at schools” methodological manual was published for school teachers with the support of “Hope and Help” NGO.

At the general education schools of Armenia, the topics on the policy of gender equality for men and women, prevention of violence against men or women, as well as topics on inclusive education were involved in the training module system for the teachers to be trained.

“Equality for men and women” topic was involved in the training system conducted for the principals, vice-principals and teachers of the vocational education institutions of Armenia.

Field of Higher Education

Within the framework of “Program on fighting against corruption and strengthening the moral norms in the system of higher education in the Republic of Armenia” funded by European Council and European Union, a number of documents on strengthening the moral norms in the system of higher education in Armenia as well as ensuring transparency and accountability were elaborated by international and local groups of experts.

A number of programs on the strategy of anti-corruption were elaborated by higher education institutions of Armenia.

Moreover, a special assessment electronic system for taking exams and modules was input in a number of higher education institutions.
