Domestic Actions and Framework (Q17-23)

- National Strategy, Agencies involved
- Domestic activities (crop eradication, ATS and precursors control, AML, etc)

- Activities (exchange of information, joint operations)
- Problems in cooperating (slow procedures, lack of agreements)
- Platforms used (WCO, Interpol, meetings)

International Technical Cooperation (Q29-30)

- Technical assistance received (type, was it sufficient)
- Technical assistance provided (type)

Precursor Chemicals Control (Q31-37)

- List? Collaboration with industries? Pre-export notification system? Post-seizure investigation? (origin, controlled deliveries)

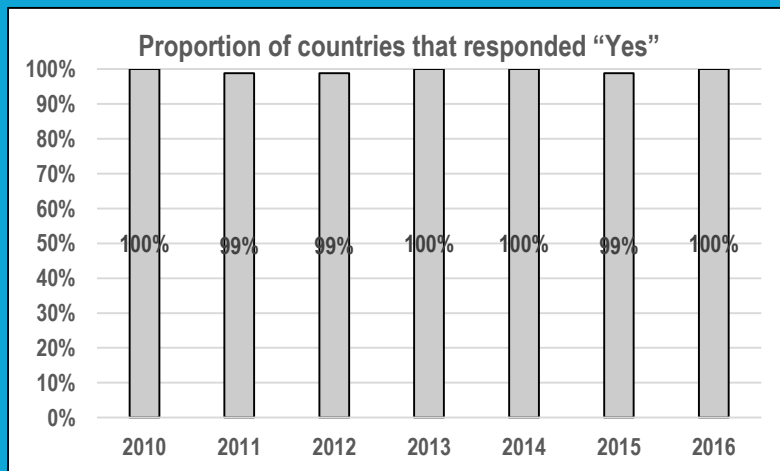

Do you have a written strategy to reduce drug supply approved by the government?

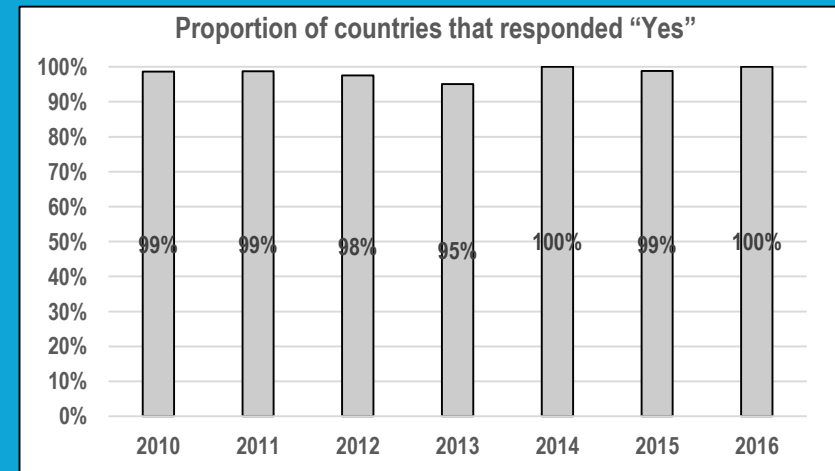
