


## Registration Guide for the Global Judicial Integrity Network Practitioner’s Corner

Why register?




How to register:

1. Users must first go to the Judicial Integrity website: [unodc.org/ji](http://unodc.org/ji)
2. Under the Network tab, they should select “register” (see below).

**TIPS:**

- This is a personal account. The user associated with the account should enter their own email address (ex. If someone is entering the information for a judge, that person should enter the judge’s email, not their own.)
- If there is a drop-down menu for a field, the user must select an option that is available, instead of typing in other information.
- Users cannot register more than once with the same email.
- Be aware that country codes for phone numbers have a different number of digits depending upon the country (ex: +20: Egypt, +220: Guatemala).
- Please enter the information without leaving blank spaces at the beginning of the fields.



4. Check the box to agree to share the contact information with other participants, and click the “submit” button.

5. Once you have clicked “submit” the following message will appear on the screen:

6. Users will then automatically receive an email from the Judicial Integrity team explaining the next steps, which looks like this:

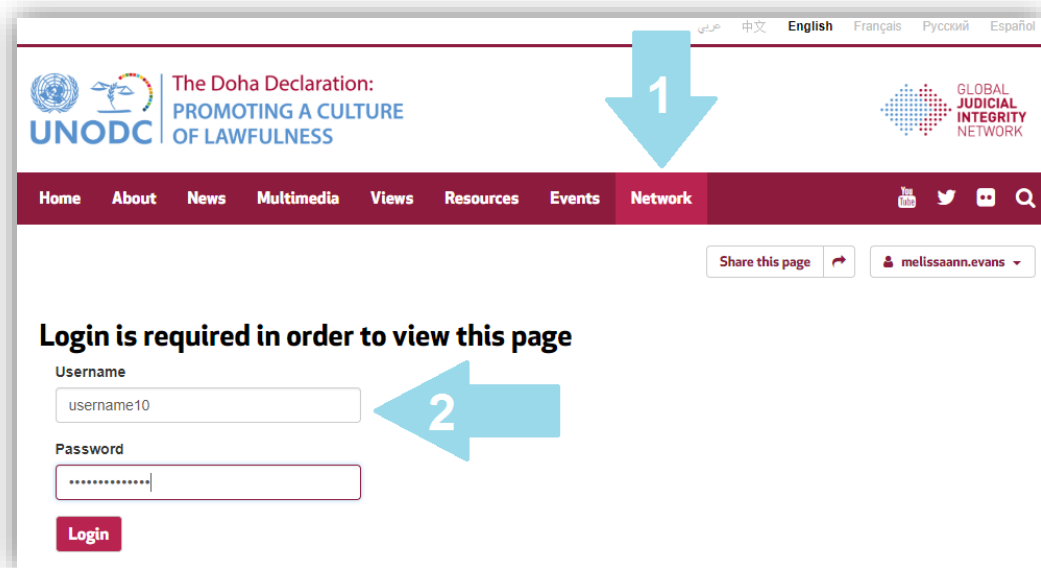
Dear participant,

Your online registration for the Global Judicial Integrity Network website has now been successfully received. For access to the Global Judicial Integrity Network website, please carefully follow these steps:

- Please wait to receive an email from the United Nations’ Unite ID website regarding the creation of your official username and password and follow the instructions provided. (Please note that when Unite ID asks for your duty country and duty city it refers to where you currently reside.)
- You will then receive an email from Unite ID confirming the creation of your account.
- This username and password may then be used to log into the restricted area of the Global Judicial Integrity Network website: <https://www.unodc.org/ji/en/network.html>
- Once you have entered your username and password you will be able to access the full content of the Global Judicial Integrity Network website.

7. At this point, the registration must be processed by the Unite ID technical team. They will send the users an email asking them to create a Unite ID account.
  - a. Please note that the Unite ID email will not be generated automatically, but instead, once the Unite ID team has manually processed the information. This process could take up to a week, as it is necessary to verify the validity of the information. We apologize for any inconveniences this may cause our users.
  - b. Users should follow the Unite ID team’s instructions in their email to create an account.
8. Once the Unite ID account has been created, the username and password can be used to log into the Global Judicial Integrity Network website.
