Who we are

The **Global Programme to Support the Mechanism for the Review of the Implementation of the United Nations Convention against Transnational Organized Crime and the Protocols thereto** (UNTOC Review Mechanism) was established in 2019 by the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC).



What we do

The Global Programme functions as the **Secretariat of the UNTOC Review Mechanism**, supports the **effective operation of the Mechanism** and **provides assistance to States parties**, upon request, to enhance their engagement in the review process.

192 parties to the Convention

189 parties are engaged in the UNTOC Review Mechanism

Types of assistance

The Global Programme organizes **capacity building activities** and **training sessions** on the UNTOC Review Mechanism and on REVMOD, the online platform for the country reviews, which supports Focal Points and Governmental Experts during all the steps of the review process.



Other types of assistance include support in filling in the **self-assessment questionnaires** and in the preparation for the **written outputs of the review process**, and **facilitating the consultations** among States parties, among others.

Publications and Tools

To further support States parties in carrying out the country reviews, a number of **publications** have been developed by the Global Programme including the Guide to the Preliminary Consultation and the REVMOD manuals for Focal Points and Governmental Experts. An **e-learning module** on the UNTOC Review Mechanism and the use of REVMOD is also available in all UN official languages.
