

## 10<sup>th</sup> Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption

Logo and Waiver of Liability



### I. Use of the logo

#### Use of the logo by the United Nations offices, Funds and Programmes and other subsidiary organs and organizations of the United Nations System

United Nations offices, Funds and Programmes and other subsidiary organs and organizations of the United Nations System may use the logo of the 10<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption without obtaining prior approval from the UN Office on Drugs and Crime. However, for reporting purposes, the UN Office on Drugs and Crime should be informed of events and informal materials and items for which the logo is issued including, *inter alia*, publications, posters, brochures, videos, pins, T-shirts etc.

The logo of the 10<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption must be used in its entirety. Moreover, if the UN office, Fund or Programme or other subsidiary organ or organization of the United Nations system has its own specific logo, the latter should be displayed side by side with the logo of the 10<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption.

#### Use of the logo by non-UN entities

Entities outside the UN system, including Governments, intergovernmental organizations, not-for-profit organizations and private sector entities, may use the logo after obtaining approval from the UN Office on Drugs and Crime in accordance with the requirements outlined below.

The logo of the 10<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption is primarily intended for information purposes. The information uses of the logo are: a) primarily illustrative, and b) not intended to raise funds.

The logo of the 10<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption must be used in its entirety. Moreover, it cannot be used alone but must be displayed side by side with the logo of the UN Office on Drugs and Crime.

UNODC's logo must be given pre-eminence vis-à-vis the logo of the 10<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption.

The authorization to use the logo of the 10<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption does not permit the user to sub-license or to further authorize the use of the logo to any other entities.

Therefore, any non-UN entity interested in using the logo of the 10<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption must apply for approval directly from the UN Office on Drugs and Crime.

While requesting approval, the entities must provide:

- A short statement of identity (nature of the entity and its objectives);
- An explanation of how and where the logo will be used, including the countries/territories where the logo will be used;
- A waiver of liability (please see form on page 4) signed by the entity requesting the logo.

## **II. Length of use of the logo**

The logo of the 10<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption may be used from May 2023 to April 2024. The logo may be used beyond April 2024 for reporting and in reference to publications about the 10<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption.

## **III. Liability**

All entities whose request to use the logo has been approved for the purposes specified herein must agree to the following provisions on waiver of liability.

- The entity is responsible for ensuring that the activities are carried out in accordance with the applicable law and for ensuring that the appropriate insurance is maintained to cover the risks arising out of such activities.
- The United Nations does not assume any responsibility for the activities of the entity.
- The entity shall hold harmless and defend the United Nations and its officials against any action that may be brought against the United Nations or its officials as a result of the use of the logo by the entity.
- The waiver of liability form, signed by the entity must be submitted with the request to use the logo. The entity will not carry out the proposed activities until the request is approved and the duly signed waiver of liability is received by the UN Office on Drugs and Crime.

#### **IV. Disclaimer**

- The logo of the 10<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption is the property of the United Nations.
- The logo of the 10<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption can only be used to identify events and activities related to the 10<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference.
- The logo of the 10<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption may only be used after a Waiver of Liability for the use of the logo of the 10<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption has been received by the UN Office on Drugs and Crime and the request to use the logo has been approved.
- By using the logo of the 10<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption the entity agrees to provide information to the UN Office on Drugs and Crime on the events and activities for which it is used. This information will be used for reporting purposes on the 9<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption.
- The authorization to use the logo of the 10<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption or the publication of an event organized by an outside entity does not imply United Nations' endorsement of the planned activity or outside entity.
- The logo of the 10<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption may not be reproduced for the purpose of self-promotion, or obtaining any commercial or personal financial gain, nor it may be used in any manner that implies United Nations' endorsement of the products or activities of a commercial enterprise.
- The United Nations will not assume any responsibility or liability arising from the translation of the text of the logo into non-official languages of the United Nations.
- Please give credit to the United Nations when using the logo of the 10<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption.
