**Mr. President,**  
**Excellencies,**  
**Distinguished delegates,**

First, I would like to congratulate Mr. President and other members of the Bureau on their election. I wish to thank the United States for hosting this session of the Conference in Atlanta and the Secretariat for its organizational support. Allow me to also express our appreciation to the outgoing Presidency and the Bureau for their leadership and guidance during the ninth session of the Conference.

**Mr. President,**

On the occasion of the twentieth anniversary of the adoption of UNCAC, I wish to reaffirm Thailand's resolute commitment to the implementation of its obligations under the Convention, and to cooperation with all States Parties.

One of our priorities is to further develop our legislation to meet international standards. As such, we are in the process of reviewing our Organic Act on Anti-Corruption to incorporate new tools into the existing law in order to further strengthen the effectiveness of the enforcement, such as special investigative techniques and the non-trial resolution mechanism for legal persons to resolve bribery and related cases.

Thailand also recognizes the significant value of close coordination among relevant agencies as well as the international cooperation to prevent, identify, investigate, and prosecute corruption. In this connection, Thailand, as a member of the GlobE Network, wishes to thank the Network for serving as a platform for information exchange among practitioners for the past two years.

In addition, Thailand attaches great importance to actively participating in the Convention's implementation review mechanism. As a Reviewing State, last month, Thailand worked closely with Honduras and the Secretariat in Ecuador to complete the country visit and we look forward to continuing our work with our colleagues towards the completion of this review cycle. We also reiterate our full recognition of the importance of the next review phase and stand ready to work with fellow States Parties and UNODC with a view to ensuring that the review mechanism in the next phase will generate positive outcomes for all States Parties.

**Mr. President,**

In closing, our delegation looks forward to constructive discussions in the upcoming days. We reaffirm our support to the US Presidency. We will continue our work and engagement throughout this session to ensure the fruitful outcomes, which will contribute to our ongoing efforts in capacity development and technical cooperation among States Parties in areas that will further advance the implementation of the Convention.
