Note by the Secretariat

1. The present note provides a summary of the status of ratification of the United Nations Convention against Corruption (General Assembly resolution 58/4, annex).

Status of ratification

2. As at 30 September 2011, the Convention had been signed by 140 States and ratified by 154 States.

3. The status of ratification of the Convention by regional group is presented in the table.
