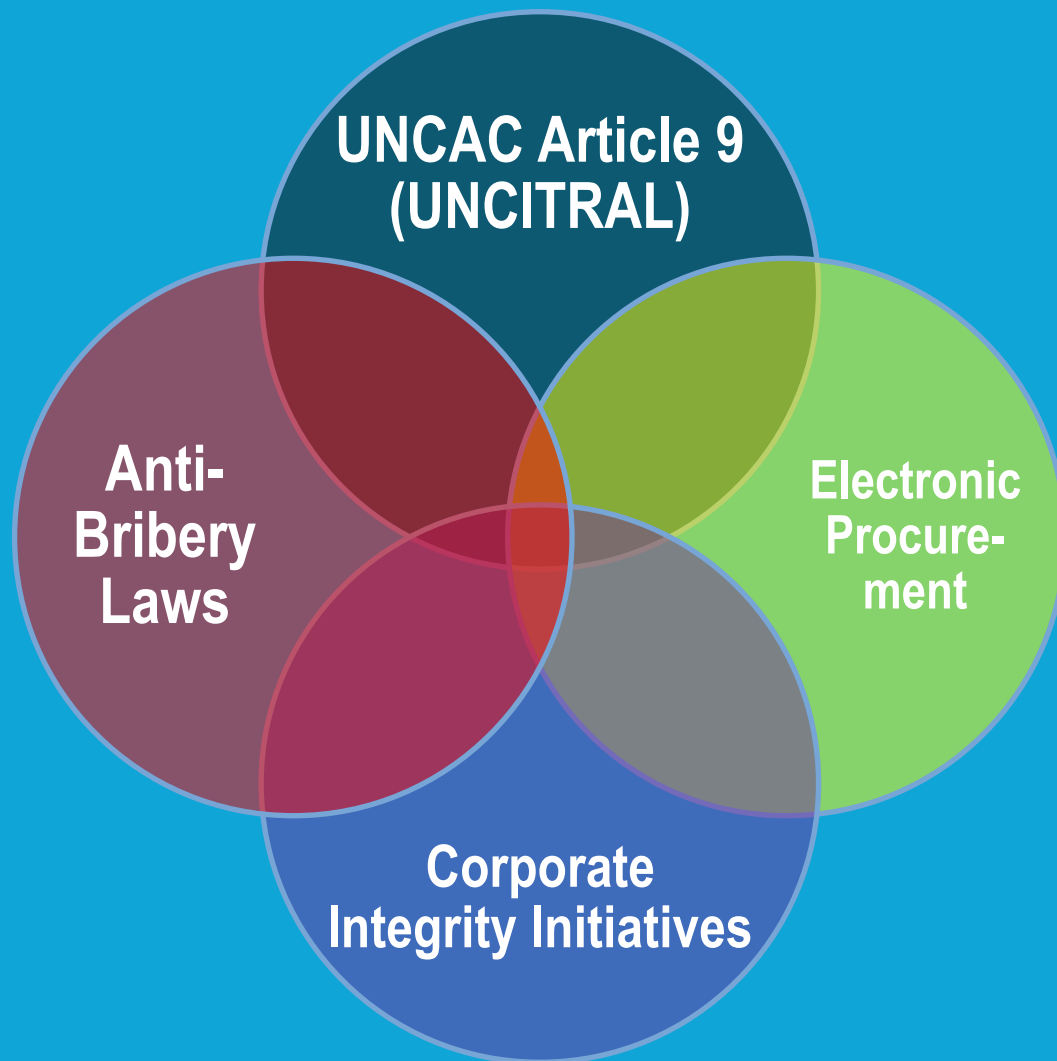

- Bid protest and appeal
